

# WHISKY

## LOWLAND

### GLENKINCHIE

12yr 43% abv 25ml

£4.4

The Edinburgh malt. Delicate & slightly floral. Hints of honey & heather with a malt finish

### AUCHENTOSHAN THREE WOOD

43% abv 25ml

£5.5

The Auchentoshan distillery was founded in 1825 on the outskirts of Glasgow. Three Wood is matured in American oak bourbon casks, Oloroso & Pedro Ximinez sherry casks producing luxurious malt full of dark fruits & caramel

## SPEYSIDE

### BALVENIE CARIBBEAN CASK

14yr 43% abv 25ml                      £5.5

A 14 year old Balvenie which finished its maturation in casks which had previously held Caribbean rum. Expect vanilla and toffee notes as the rum contributes extra sweetness to the flavours

### GLENFIDDICH

15yr 40% abv 25ml                      £5.5

A delightful malt matured in American bourbon, Portuguese sherry & virgin oak casks. The whisky is then married in a Solera vat producing a well-balanced 15 year old staple from the distillery



## HIGHLAND & ISLANDS

### MACALLAN DOUBLE CASK

12yr 40% abv 25ml £6.5

Aged in a combination of American oak and ex-sherry casks the Double Cask combines fruity citrus with pleasant caramel followed by ginger & nutmeg

### DALMORE CIGAR MALT RESERVE

44% abv 25ml £9

Dalmore Cigar Malt Reserve is taken from a selection of aged stocks from 10 – 15 years, matured in both American white-oak bourbon barrels and Matusalem oloroso sherry casks before a final finesse in Cabernet Sauvignon wine barriques

### TALISKER PORT RUIGHE

45.8% abv 25ml £6.5

The Malt is finished in Ruby Port casks which leads to a powerful maritime character combined with succulent sweet notes of rich berry fruits for a superbly contrasting taste

## CAMPBELTOWN

### SPRINGBANK

10yr 46% abv 25m £4.5

Springbank is perched on the edge of Campbeltown Loch towards the bottom of the Kintyre peninsula in the West of Scotland. Dried herbs, salty, with hints of moss and toffee-apple

### LONGROW

46% abv 25ml £5.5

Longrow is a peated, double-distilled malt produced at the Springbank distillery. Salt and a leathery smokiness come to the fore on the palate in a maritime combination, like a Harbourmaster's Jacket, leading to an exceptionally long, fresh finish

### HIGHLAND PARK

18yr 43% abv 25ml £12

One of our all-time favourites, this has to be one of the most consistently excellent malt whiskies of the last ten years. A stunning balance of smokey dryness with heather & malty tones leading to a notably lingering finish



## ISLAY

### LAPHROAIG

10yr 40% abv 25ml £4.8

A classic Islay dram, full bodied with a residual sweetness, medicinal peat leads to hints of seaweed & petrol on a long warming finish

### KILCHOMAN MACHIR BAY

46% abv 25ml £5.5

The Kilchomen distillery was founded in 2005 at the Rochside Farm, not far from Machir Bay at Islay's West Coast. Sherried and oaky palate with notes of cracked black pepper, butterscotch and apple

### BUNNAHABHAIN

18yr 46.3% abv 25ml £10.5

This beautiful golden spirit's nose releases honeyed nuts, leathery oak and a slightly sea-induced salty tang. The palate is influenced by mellow sherried nuts, rich toffee and shavings of the finest natural oak wood

### BRUICHLADDICH BLACK ART 6.1

26yr 46.9% abv 25ml £25

This is the sixth edition of Bruichladdich's Black Art series. The whisky is created by master distiller Adam Hannett & the composition is a secret. Lose yourself in the sweet, fruity, mellow oakiness of this bewitching spirit

## BLENDED

### COMPASS BOX SPICETREE

46% abv 25ml £5.5

The Spice Tree is made from Highland malt whiskies which aged in custom-made casks fitted with new French oak heads. The result is a big malt whisky of richness and spice-like complexity

### SCALLYWAG

46% abv 25ml £4.5

Sallywag is a Small Batch bottling using only Speyside Malts including Glenrothes, Mortlach and Macallan. Sherry influences various stages of this Blend's production leading to fruitcake, orange zest and hints of sweet tobacco

### JOHNNIE WALKER BLUE KING GEORGE V

43% abv 25ml £30

The King George V edition is handmade in the same tradition as Johnnie Walker Blue Label. This blend captures a delicate balance of the peatiness, smoke and power of West coast whiskies with the lighter, fruitier and aromatic qualities of those from Speyside



## IRISH

### REDBREAST

12yr 46% abv 25ml £5

A paradigm of Irish Whisky! Single pot, triple distilled at the Midleton Distillery and then aged in Oloroso sherry casks. Clean, grassy and smooth this delicate whiskey invokes flavours of white grape to fresh rain

## JAPANESE

### NIKKA TAKETSURU PURE MALT

43% abv 25ml £5

This Blended Malt contains a high percentage of malt from Miyagikyo with the remainder coming from Yoichi Distillery. Aged on average for 10 years in a variety of casks with some sherry wood for extra richness. A great introduction to Japanese whisky

### SUNTORY YAMAZAKI

12yr 43% abv 25ml £7

The nose is well malted with definite hints of blossom, warm honey and butterscotch. The malt remains highly visible and has a buttery quality; it is accompanied by oak flavours with hints of vanilla and orange zest

### SUNTORY HIBIKI

17yr 43% abv 25ml £8

Polished wood and candle wax, with citrus undertones, and a hint of bitter chocolate. A blend with real depth of flavour which has put Japan firmly on the whisky map

## AMERICAN

### ELIJAH CRAIG SMALL BATCH

12yr 47% abv 25ml £4.2

On the palate, it has a slightly oily feel to it and the taste of caramel, oak, late arriving rye and spices linger long on the tongue. At 94 proof, the alcohol does not overpower the balanced flavours

### RITTENHOUSE STRAIGHT RYE 100 PROOF

50% abv 25ml £4.2

This complex, potent spirit is perfect for a rye Manhattan, and amazingly won 'World's Best American Whiskey' at the World Whisky Awards 2010, beating off competition from George T. Stagg

### HUDSON BABY BOURBON

46% abv 25ml £6.5

The first legal pot-still whisky to be produced in New York since prohibition. Made from 100% corn and aged on new charred American oak, this a fruity dram full of caramel, prune and vanilla

### COLONEL E.H. TAYLOR SINGLE BARREL

50% abv 25ml £9.5

Colonel Edmund Haynes Taylor, Jr. is one of the founding fathers of the bourbon industry, fighting for the Bottled-in-Bond Act of 1897, nearly three decades after he purchased what is now called Buffalo Trace Distillery. Sweet and buttery; with a surprising hint of orange peel





# CIGAR MATCHING

## PUNCH CORONATION £17

This fine vitola delivers a superb draw full of floral notes and hints of white pepper in a medium bodied Cuban cigar

### **Whisky Recommendation:**

Ideally matched with a subtle, peated malt we would propose Springbank Longrow or Talisker 10yr

## H. UPMANN CORONAS JUNIOR £15

This small Havana promises to have a good future; attractive, good draw, thick smoke with creamy hints of coffee & some nutty flavours

### **Whisky Recommendation:**

Ideally enjoyed with a spicy Highland malt we would recommend Balblair 2005 or Highland Park 18yr

## ROMEO Y JULIETA ROMEO NO.3 £20

Medium in strength and a characteristic Romeo y Julieta style. Robust and complex with floral, nutty & herbal flavours

### **Whisky Recommendation:**

Ideally paired with a sherry finished malt we would suggest Auchentoshan 3 Wood or Dalmore Cigar Malt
